Art Festival Right Here in Our Area. Everyone is invited to attend a (**free admission**) art festival on the Spotsylvania Courthouse grounds and in Berea Church right across the street. The dates are **Saturday, August 11 from 10-6 and Sunday, August 12 from 11-4.** The artists, from all over the United States, will be selling their hand-crafted creative pieces/items such as metal works, glass, jewelry, and, of course, lovely paintings.
