### Rite I

Almighty God, whose Son our Savior Jesus Christ was lifted high upon the cross that he might draw the whole world unto himself: Mercifully grant that we, who glory in the mystery of our redemption, may have grace to take up our cross and follow him; who liveth and reigneth with thee and the Holy Spirit, one God, in glory everlasting. *Amen.*

### Rite II

Almighty God, whose Son our Savior Jesus Christ was lifted high upon the cross that he might draw the whole world to himself: Mercifully grant that we, who glory in the mystery of our redemption, may have grace to take up our cross and follow him; who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, in glory everlasting. *Amen.*

## **A Reading from the Book of Isaiah**

Declare and present your case;  
let them take counsel together!

Who told this long ago?  
Who declared it of old?

Was it not I, the LORD?  
There is no other god besides me,  
a righteous God and a Saviour;  
there is no one besides me.

Turn to me and be saved,  
all the ends of the earth!  
For I am God, and there is no other.  
By myself I have sworn,  
from my mouth has gone forth in  
righteousness  
a word that shall not return:  
“To me every knee shall bow,  
every tongue shall swear.”

Only in the LORD, it shall be said of me,  
are righteousness and strength;  
all who were incensed against him  
shall come to him and be ashamed.  
In the LORD all the offspring of Israel  
shall triumph and glory. (45:21-25)

the LORD,  
when he comes to judge the earth.

In righteousness shall he judge the world \*  
and the peoples with equity.

### **A Reading from the Letter of Paul to the Galatians**

May I never boast of anything except the  
cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, by which the  
world has been crucified to me, and I to the  
world. For neither circumcision nor  
uncircumcision is anything; but a new  
creation is everything! As for those who will  
follow this rule-- peace be upon them, and  
mercy, and upon the Israel of God.

From now on, let no one make trouble for me; for I carry the marks of Jesus branded on my body.

May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with your spirit, brothers and sisters.  
Amen. (6:14-18)

### **A Reading from the Holy Gospel according to John**

Jesus said, “Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out. And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people to myself.” He said this to indicate the kind of death he was to die. The crowd answered him, “We have heard from the law that the Messiah remains forever. How can you say that the Son of Man must be lifted up? Who is this Son of Man?” Jesus said to them, “The light is with you for a little longer. Walk while you have the light, so that the darkness may not overtake you. If you walk in the darkness, you do not know where you are going. While you have the light, believe in the light, so that you may become children of light.” (12:31-36a)

*For those watching the service on Zoom or Facebook Live, the following prayer may be said during communion:*

My Jesus, I believe that You are present in the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Never permit me to be separated from You. *Amen.*
