ECW Thank Offering. The ECW will be taking up a collection in September for their Thank Offering which will benefit the Central Virginia Justice Initiative. Operating since 2014, this Fredericksburg area non-profit has expanded its services from education, prevention, training and advocacy to include crisis support, referrals and case management for survivors of human trafficking, especially commercial sex trafficking. We provide emergency backpacks and transportation within Virginia to a safe shelter. CVJI is a founding member along with Rappahannock Area Council Against Sexual Assault of the Planning District 16 Human Trafficking Task Force which is working to provide better access to services (e.g. housing) for survivors. CVJI is also an advisor for Virginia Coalition Against Human Trafficking which advocates for survivor-centered human trafficking legislation. CVJI relies on trained and screened volunteers.
