Food Pantry Garden: MAY UPDATE

Last season was truly bountiful! As of August, we produced 300 pounds of vegetables...but our work wasn't done yet. The growing season ended in early October with a final yield of <u>438</u> <u>pounds</u> of vegetables! Amazing!

We have begun preparing the garden for planting. The beds have been weeded. Next, we'll add dirt and mix in 'black gold' (thank you Charles). Then comes the planting: bush beans, bell peppers, cucumbers, tomatoes, and maybe more!

All the vegetables we grow are donated to our Food Pantry and distributed to our clients. Our pantry is one of the few, if not the <u>only</u> in our area, that provides freshly grown vegetables to clients.

A key part of gardening is maintenance. Wooden raised garden beds have a 4- or 5-year life span before they begin to fall apart. Last year we began replacing these wooden raised garden beds with galvanized steel beds. We started with four 3x6 foot beds. This year, Mark De Polo built two additional 4x8 foot galvanized steel beds. Mark also set up a professional irrigation system for the tomato garden. Not only is this a huge timesaver (in the past it would have taken over an hour to water 30 tomato plants) but it is also a more efficient use of our water supply. Looking ahead, we have plans to install a gate at the back of the garden for easier access to the tomato garden.

And, of course, a garden can't exist without gardeners. I'd like to thank all of our volunteer gardeners who have gotten their hands dirty. None of this would be possible without each of you. Finally, a note of appreciation for the guy who inspires us and leads us in prayers: Thanks Fr. Daniel for your continued spiritual support throughout the gardening season.
